I can't imagine what my grandparents would think if they were alive today. All the changes that they would have seen. I just returned from a Michigan Township Conference. In one of the classes I attended they said that in the future all accounts (checking, savings, statements, etc.) would be replaced with bar codes instead of numbers. **Tax payments need to be in my office by mail or in person by 5 pm February 14. Any payments received after that date will be charged the 3% penalty for summer and winter.**

The Presidential Primary election was held January 15<sup>th</sup>. If you missed that election you can vote again in the August 5<sup>th</sup> 2008 Primary, the November 4<sup>th</sup> 2008 General Election. There is also a School Board election in the spring.

- Registration Deadlines: Last day to register for August Primary is July 7<sup>th</sup> 2008. The last day to register for General Election is October 6<sup>th</sup>, 2008. Absent voter applications are available on the internet and at the Township Office for voters that qualify.
- Request for street lights on M-84 were approved by the State and installed by Consumers Power at M-84 and Amelith Rd and on M-84 at Berger's Tavern driveway.
- Water line is installed and tested at S. Euclid and E. Stone Island Rd.
- City of Saginaw: A letter was received allowing water connection on its transmission main on Freeland Road for a period of one year commencing September 1, 2007 to August 31, 2008.

Road Patrol update: The County has undertaken an additional deputy position. The Township shall assume 40% of the cost. The agreement made to be effective 2007/2008 fiscal year. The monthly allocation is \$657.58.

- The Township Board thanks the Public for the approval of the Safety and Fire Department millage approved in the November election.
- Our annual Audit Report was accepted by Berthiaume & Company.
- Election Request Endorsements: A motion was made and supported to reaffirm to the public that the Township Board policy on record **does not endorse or approve** any election request as was stated in the Bay City Times prior to the last November 6<sup>th</sup> Election.
- The road work on I-75 from Birch Run to Bay City Interchange 10 will continue this coming summer. An additional lane will be added in each direction.
- A summary of votes cast at the Primary Election in Frankenlust Township on January 15<sup>th</sup> (750 voted).

**Taxable Value:** The Consumer Price Index applied to the 2007 taxable values to create 2008 taxable values is 102.3%.

**State Equalized Value:** The tentative residential factor for the upcoming year hasn't been finalized. Last year it did not increase. This year it may well be a negative number, albeit a small one, around 1%. We are using a one year sales study (from October 1, 2006 through September 30, 2007) rather than the usual two year study as per State Tax Commission guidelines.

Assessment change notices will be sent to property owners in mid February. If there are no changes in either Assessed or Taxable Value no notices will be sent. **Paul Arnold**

A total of 21 Township Officers were elected: 1 Supervisor 1 Clerk 1 Treasurer 1 Highway Commissioner  
1 Drain Commissioner  
2 School Inspectors  
4 Justices of the Peace  
4 Constables  
6 Road Overseers

Twenty-five cents per \$100 tax valuation was raised for Highway work.
