

**WATER RATE ORDINANCE; BAY COUNTY
WATER SUPPLY SYSTEM
TOWNSHIP OF FRANKENLUST, MICHIGAN
ord. no. 22 eff. Sept. 12, 1978**

An Ordinance establishing rates, charges and rules for the use and service of the Bay County Water Supply System, Frankenlust Township, 1978:

THE TOWNSHIP OF FRANKENLUST, COUNTY OF BAY AND STATE OF MICHIGAN ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Sec. 1. RATES AND CHARGES.

There shall be and are hereby established quarterly rates and charges for the use of and for the services supplies by the Bay County Water Supply System, Frankenlust Township, 1978, based upon the meter readings of the amount of water consumed, as follows:

A. Water Rates - Quarterly Billings

Commodity Charges are as follows: \$1.57 per thousand gallons on all billable consumption.

B. Connection Charge

Said connection charges shall be increased by the sum of two hundred (\$200.00) dollars per annum on July 1st of each year thereafter.

C. Tank Sales

\$0.25 per each 145 gallons.

D. Turn On Charges

There will be imposed a charge of \$20.00 whenever the Township is requested to turn on or off water services: provided, however, whenever the Township is requested to provide turn on or off service at times other than the regular business hours of the Township there will be imposed an additional charge of \$20.00.

E. Replacement Charges

There shall be a charge for replacement of water lines in such amount as shall, from time to time, be provided by appropriate resolution adopted pursuant to law, by the Township Board, and when so adopted, shall be incorporated herein by reference and made a part hereof.

Surplus revenues, if any, on hand at the end of any fiscal period may, at the discretion of the Township Board, by appropriate resolution, be transferred in such amount as the Township Board shall direct to a replacement fund. Upon adoption of such resolution and delivery of a copy thereof the Department of Public Works, transfer of such surplus funds to the replacement fund, shall be effected by the Department of Public Works.

F. Charges For Service Outside Corporate Limits of Township

Rates for water service outside the corporate limits of the Township, including quarterly billings, connection charges, turn on charges, replacement charges, deposit and all other lawful charges shall, from time to time, be established by appropriate resolution adopted pursuant to law, by the Township Board, and when so adopted, shall be incorporated herein and become a part hereof.

G. Connections

No more than one customer per connection, whether residential or nonresidential, shall be permitted. All connections shall be made in conformity with current rules and regulations of the Bay County Department of Water and

Sewer, which rules and regulations, as from time to time amended, are incorporated herein and made a part hereof.

Sec. 2. BILLS; DELINQUENT CHARGES; TURNING OFF WATER; LIEN.

Bills for the rates and charges as herein established by the Township shall be mailed quarterly. All bills shall be payable on the due date as shown on the bill, and shall be paid at the office of the Department of Public Works or authorized substation. If any charge for the services of the system shall not be paid by the due date, a delayed payment charge of one percent (1%) per month of the unpaid amount of the bill shall be added thereto and collected therewith. If any bills for the service of the System shall remain unpaid after 60 days following the rendition of the bill therefore, the water supply for the lot, parcel of land, or premises affected shall be cut off and shall not be turned on again except on payment in full of the delinquent charges therefore, in addition to the payment of the charge of \$20.00. In addition to any other remedy provided by law for the collection of bills for services rendered as provided herein, the Township shall have a lien on the premises as provided by statute in such case made and provided.

Sec. 3. AGENT FOR TOWNSHIP.

It is hereby made the duty of the Bay County Department of Public Works as agent for the Township to render bills for service and all other charges in connection therewith and to collect all moneys due therefore.

Sec. 4. REPEAL.

All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions hereof, including the provisions of Ordinance No. 19 adopted the 21st day of June 1978, are hereby repealed.

Sec. 5. TITLE.

This Ordinance shall be known as and referred to as the Bay County Water Supply System, Frankenlust Township, 1978, Water Rate Ordinance, and the provisions hereof applicable to that area of the Township serviced thereby.

Sec. 6. PUBLICATION; RECORDING.

This Ordinance shall be published in full in The Bay City Times, a newspaper of general circulation in the Township, promptly after its adoption, and shall be recorded in the Ordinance Book of the Township and such recording authenticated by the signatures of the Supervisor and Township Clerk.

Sec. 7. EFFECTIVE DATE.

This Ordinance is hereby determined by the Township Board to be immediately necessary for the preservation of the peace, health and safety of the Township and is therefore declared to have immediate effect.
